The twelfth Station: Jesus dies on the cross



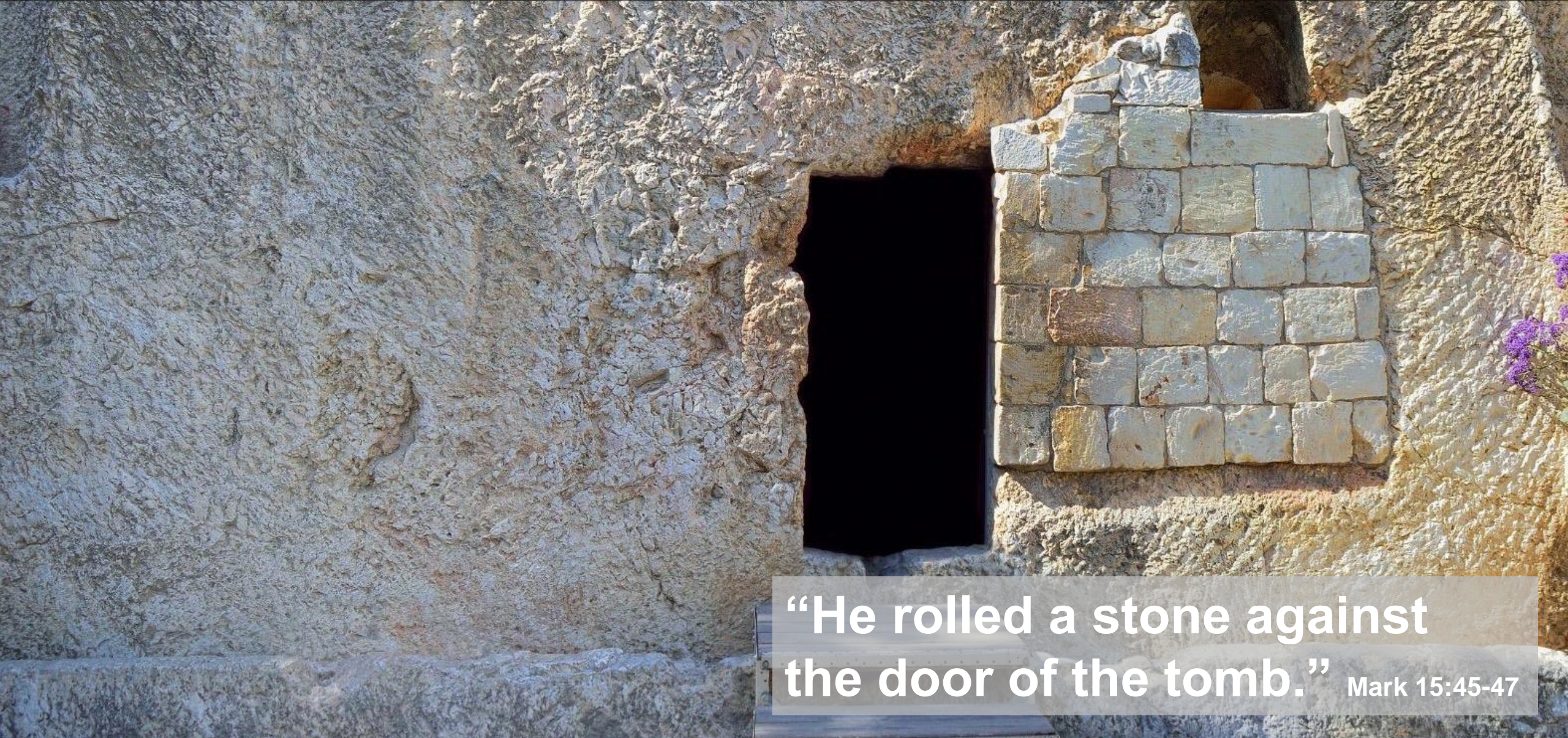
“I am thirsty.” John 19:28
